Rules and Regulations for Vendors and Exhibitors

General Information

Location: Copper Sky Regional Park
 Date: February 12, 2022 (Saturday)
 Time: 10am – 3pm

Artists may purchase up to two squares. Each space is approximately 10' x 10' - may be a little larger, may be a little smaller. The exhibit area is in the park's amphitheater, south of the pond. The Chalk Arts area will be the sidewalk going through the festival.

All spaces will be marked off and numbered by the event staff. All spaces will be assigned by the event staff.

The Chalk Art and Art for the Heart Festival is a community event that is open to the general Public. All spaces must be appropriate for the general Public; no "adult-only" areas or information will be allowed. All artists must comply with all state, county, and local laws. Drug paraphernalia or pro drug literature is not

allowed. Sexually explicit items, and items with violent content is not allowed. Guns and gun sales are not allowed.

Artists may not change their space without the expressed permission of the event staff.

Set-up will begin at 9 a.m. Artists will be allowed to drive their vehicle into the marketplace area and unload after 9 a.m., but must immediately move vehicles. All vehicles must be out of the vendor area no later than 10am.

The event opens to the Public at 10am. and goes through 4:00 p.m.

This is a "rain-or-shine" event, and no refunds will be given due to inclement weather.

Artists may not sell or give away food products, drink products, or water. These products are limited to the Food Court.

Artists are encouraged to bring their own table and/or chairs and/or umbrella. **IF YOU ARE BRINGING A TENT FOR SHADE**: All tents must be self-supporting and include weights to prevent the wind from toppling it. No spikes may be used in the asphalt to stabilize the tent. Tent **MUST NOT** cover the sidewalk.

Chalk Artists **MAY NOT** sell their artwork/warez. Artists may give away samples, door prizes, and distribute information concerning products/services from their space.

Personal sound systems in booths are prohibited unless all emitted sound is contained to the individual booth.

No alcohol, drugs, or guns are permitted on park grounds. Violators may be arrested and prosecuted by the Pinal County Sheriff's Department.

If a vendor or exhibitor violates these event Rules and Regulations, they will be immediately dismissed from the festival and no refund given for their fee.

Attendance

The attendance at the Art for the Heart Festival has grown each year, and we are anticipating a large amount of people. The Chalk Arts Festival is completely new. There is no guarantee of attendance (or sales). The Art for the Heart and Chalk Arts Festival is an outdoor festival, and is affected by many uncontrollable factors. The festival is marketed and advertised extensively.

Hold Harmless Agreement

Artists have been advised and understand the Rules and Regulations for the Chalk Arts Festival, and is bound by the terms and conditions outlined by them. Artists are solely responsible for the quality and safety of what they sell or services they promote. Vendor shall indemnify, keep and hold harmless the Maricopa Arts Council, its volunteers, its members, and all agencies the Festival has agreements with from and against any and all claims and demands, whether for injuries to persons, or loss of life, or damage to property, on or off the premises, arising out of the use or occupancy of the premises by the artist and shall defend at the artists own expense any action brought against the Festival and/or any of the above-mentioned organizations or any other person or organization with which the Festival has a contractual relationship by vendor's acts or omissions.
